

The Knowledge Exchange Agreement allowed all Dutch institutions to access BioOne Complete free of charge for three years, 2009 to 2011. 

BioOne Complete offers 53 Zoology titles, including African Zoology, Copeia, Journal of Ethnobiology, Malacologia, South American Journal of Herpetology, Ursus, Wilderness & Environmental Medicine, Zoosystema.

UvA decided to continue with a paid subscription to BioOne Complete after the Knowledge Exchange Agreement concluded. Then, in 2013-2014, the Zoology and Toxicology departments moved to Leiden University. Continuing to promote and evaluate BioOne, Mr. Meerburg and his team again identified increased usage of BioOne Complete, particularly in the areas of Ecology and Evolution. This coincided with BioOne's addition of more ecology and evolution journals particularly relevant for these departments and of interest to biologists and researchers. With 62 titles in Ecology and 20 titles in Evolutionary Biology, including niche titles like Freshwater Science, BioOne Complete has become an attractive and valuable investment for **UvA**.

There are currently 204 BioOne papers published by authors from **UvA**, which helps boost the University's profile and reputation across Europe and around the world. "We are also sympathetic to the publication model, being not for profit and a mission-based organisation is positive," said Mr. Meerburg. "BioOne Complete supports open access, too, which is also very important in the Netherlands."
