The following Cases are now closed:

Case 3845: Proposed confirmation of the type species of *Pseudochloritis* Boettger, 1909, with the preservation of *Helix incrassata* Klein, 1853, a junior primary homonym of *Helix incrassata* Reeve, 1853 (Mollusca, Gastropoda, Helicoidea). Dietrich Kadolsky. (Acknowledgement of receipt published in BZN 78: 2; Case not published). Following discussion with the author, the Case is now closed.

Case 3855: Proposed conservation of *Sandbergeria* Bosquet *in* Weinkauff, 1860 (Mollusca, Gastropoda) in its accustomed sense by designating *Pyramidella cancellata* Nyst, 1836 as type species. Dietrich Kadolsky and Ronald Janssen. (Acknowledgement of receipt published in BZN 78: 68; Case not published). Following discussion with the author, the Case is now closed.
