

Map 1. Distribution of records for *Gnorimoschema gallaesolidaginum*. Filled circles indicate localities where I saw light-bunged galls on *Solidago altissima-S. canadensis* complex; half-filled circles, localities from pinned museum adults (BM, CNC, ECK, USNM); open circles, published records (Riley 1869, Brodie 1909a, Stebbins 1910, Leiby 1922, Sabrosky 1934, Barber 1938, Brimley 1938, Procter 1946, Bergeron and O'Neil 1968). Pinned-specimen and published records are of uncertain value because of close similarity between *G. gallaesolidaginum* and *G. jocelynae*; such records mapped only in areas where sightings of light-bunged galls were absent or sparse. Off-map specimen records are Fernie, British Columbia; Round Hill, Nova Scotia; Ohio, Nova Scotia; and Pullman, WA (CNC, USNM).
