## NAMES REMOVED FROM MOSQUITO GENERA

A certain number of species described in culicid genera apparently do not belong in the family. These are listed below.

- flavovirens* Robineau-Desvoidy, Culex. France.  
1827:410 (A). Type-loc: Gallia, [France?] (LU). Edwards 1932a:212 (probably Fam. Chironomidae).
- Ianio* Linnaeus, Culex. Rumania.  
1771:541 (A). Type-loc: Banat and Vallachiae, [Rumania] (LU). Stone, Knight, and Starcke 1959:287 (Fam. Simuliidae).
