NEW SERVICE FOR AUTHORS PREPARING FINAL TYPESCRIPTS OF ARTICLES FOR WDA's MICROPRINT JOURNAL WILDLIFE DISEASE

A new IBM-typescript service will be available by September 1, 1968 to authors of articles approved for publication in WDA's microprint Journal WILDLIFE DISEASE. The service, provided at cost to WDA members through W-D's editor, Dr. C. M. Herman, is offered by Carter Press, Ames, Iowa, the firm that prints the BULLETIN OF THE WILDLIFE DISEASE ASSOCIATION. This service consists of preparation of a new typescript recorded on tape, with a hard copy printed out and returned to the author for final approval and correction, and then a final corrected typescript suitable for photocopy and reduction on microfilm is prepared. This results in a uniform product indistinguishable from the finest printed copy and replaces the non-uniform, non-"justified" typescripts prepared by authors or their assistants. The service will be provided at minimum cost which is 50c per 1000 characters or approximately \$2.00 per printed page (8 1/2 x 11" paper with a 7 1/2 x 10" composition size) using 12 point type. This font includes light face, bold face, and italics. Authors with manuscripts accepted for publication in WILDLIFE DISEASE who have not yet prepared final typescripts of their material for photocopy may apply to Dr. Herman for this service.
