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Pyramidanthe* and *Mitrella* (*Annonaceae*, *Uvarieae*) unified: molecular phylogenetic and morphological congruence, with new combinations in *Pyramidanthe

On p. 387, in the description of *Pyramidanthe*, the petals were described as follows:

“*Petals* 6, in 2 whorls, each whorl valvate; outer whorl much larger than inner whorl, elliptic-obovate, ovate, ovate-triangular to narrowly ovate-triangular; inner whorl marginally cohering at anthesis, base of each inner petal excavated adaxially.”

The phrase “base of each inner petal” was incorrect and in fact refers to the outer petals. The petal description is therefore amended as follows:

“*Petals* 6, in 2 whorls, each whorl valvate; petals of outer whorl much larger than those of inner whorl, elliptic-obovate, ovate, ovate-triangular to narrowly ovate-triangular, base excavated adaxially; petals of inner whorl marginally cohering at anthesis.”

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
