Error bars show the standard error. Across all three figures, bars with the same letter are not significantly different. All points with LSM of 3 are significantly different than those with 1 or less. All points with LSM of 0 are significantly different than those with 2 or more. Points with LSM of 0.5 and 2.5 are significantly different. All other combinations of points are not significantly different from one another. These figures show a significant effect of antibiotic treatment by bacteria by moss strain. However, it is likely the effect is due to experimental error.
